Dear dog owners,

We would be happy to warmly welcome your wellbehaved and house-trained darlings to the Brandstatthof Leogang.

Please bring a blanket for your dog, because the couch and bed are reserved for masters.

We ask for your understanding that we charge the cleaning of contaminated bedding.

We allow ourselves to charge EUR 10.00 per night (without food).

Please note that the grass from the surrounding meadows is used to produce feed for our animals. We therefore ask you not to leave any poop (not even in a bag!) In the meadows! This creates serious diseases in the farm animals.

A dog station is only a few minutes away from the farm.

BEHAVIOUR RULES FOR DEALING WITH GRASSING LIFESTYLE

- 1. Avoid contact with grazing cattle, **do not feed animals, keep a safe distance!**
- 2. Keep calm, do not frighten grazing cattle!
- 3. Suckler cows protect their calves. Avoid encounters between suckler cows and dogs!
- 4. Always keep dogs under control and keep them on a short leash. If an attack by a grazing animal is foreseeable: **leash off immediately!**
- 5. Do not leave the hiking trails on alpine pastures and pastures!
- 6. If grazing cattle are blocking the path, **keep** as far away as possible!
- 7. When grazing cattle approach: stay calm, do not turn your back, avoid the animals!
- 8. As soon as the animals show signs of restlessness, **leave the pasture quickly!**
- 9. **Pay attention to fences!** If there is a gate, use it, then close it again and quickly cross the pasture!
